What is “The CleanScene Company”?

Recently, we were contacted by a “high end property” Project Management company who was planning a project to work on a house where the occupant had died and not been found for six months. They, rightly, would not work on the house until they were sure it was safe from all potential contamination.

After the death, the body had decomposed, and fluids had seeped into the first-floor subfloor, on, into the basement. Also, the horrendous smell permeated the entire dwelling and exterior, alerting the neighborhood. The Project Manager, first, two competitors, a local company that advertises as a “Crime Scene Clean-Up Company”! The first company simply tore out the baseboards and tried to clean the floor but never really ridded the house of bodily fluid residues and thus, the smell remained. The second company made “flood cuts” to a high section of the walls (which is what you do for water damage from flooding) and left the Project Manager still to deal with the smell. Neither had perfected a complete remediation.

CleanScene was then called in to consult on the project and soon formulated a plan to “test” the complete dwelling for blood proteins and analytes using a microbiologist and mycologist. Upon the results, a complete targeted decontamination and remediation was affected..... the smell was eliminated!!

BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS

Significant amounts of blood can lead to the potential for contamination or infection due to blood borne pathogens or other bacteria. Additionally, there is the difficulty of cleaning blood from different types of materials and surfaces (including porous surfaces) and determining that all trace is *completely removed*.

If the biorecovery is not performed properly, or proper personal safety precautions are not used, you risk spreading the contamination to others or exposing yourself to potentially infectious pathogens now and in the future.

SANITIZING

Re-renting to a new tenant after the previous tenant's "personal health habits and lifestyle" could, perhaps, be called into question: or, after someone who was simply "nasty", can pose potential serious health risks for your new tenants.

In a world where numerous pathogens exist and mutate exponentially, pathogens have adapted to "survive" the general consumer-used cleaning products. Therefore, it just makes smart sense TO KNOW that your property, before each rental or sale, was thoroughly sanitized by a company that provides you a "record" of its processes.



MOLD TREATMENT

In the past few years, studies performed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and its Science Advisory Board have consistently ranked indoor pollution among the top five environmental risks to public health. We apply EPA certified chemicals after the source of the mold has been identified and removed. Therefore, trained properly to use mold killing enzymes, we

kill mold and mildew that can cause allergies and disease.



WHAT IS BIORECOVERY?

Biorecovery is the safe, effective removal of blood, tissue, fluids and other biohazardous wastes that are found at the scenes of crime, trauma or unattended death.

The Center for Disease Control states that 4 1/2 million people are infected with either Hepatitis B or C with up to 80% unaware that they are infected. The CDC has determined that multiple strains of Hepatitis and HIV can survive in dried blood for **at least 7 days, some as long as a month.**

CleanScene's ABRA and NIDS trained biorecovery technicians are needed to properly remediate these environments by removing contaminated articles and properly applying EPA registered disinfectants. The exposure to infectious bloodborne pathogens is enhanced and the need to clean up these environments as soon as possible is necessary to relieve the stress on the family and return the area to a safe and habitable condition.

Persons and or businesses without the proper training can be fined for violations of the Code of Federal Regulations §29CFR 1910.1030.

WHAT IS CLEANSCENE?

CleanScene BioRecovery Services cleans and sanitizes homes, businesses, cars and apartments where a traumatic crime or accident has occurred. We remove any potentially harmful blood or bodily fluids (BSI-Body Substance Isolation) (all bodily fluids have the potential to be contaminated) because these contaminants can pose serious health consequences for those living or working in these areas.

We recognize the emotional stress that these scenes can have on the family, friends or coworkers associated with the victim. 
